GUERNSEY POST RESPONSE TO DOCUMENT OUR 05/22

At its September meeting the Guernsey Post Board considered your consultation document OUR 05/22 regarding the proposed new postal tariffs requested by Guernsey Post.

The Board was pleased with the tone and approach adopted by the OUR and believed that it reflected a constructive understanding of the issues facing the company in a rapidly changing market.

I also advised the Board that currently the OUR intended to release its determination on 5th December and that with such tight timescales it would not be possible for a draft decision notice to be published.

The Board accept that both parties were operating within tight timescales and welcomed the information that regular communication was assisting the progress of your Office's work and it was hoped would prevent the areas of concern developing that had arisen during the 2003/04 tariff determination process.

I shall continue to keep the Board apprised of developments as necessary through oral updates at future meetings.
